A. Service

1. THIS COURT ORDERS that the time for service of the Notice of Motion and the Motion Record is hereby abridged and validated that this Motion is properly returnable today and hereby dispenses with further service thereof.

B. Fees, Receipts and Disbursements

- 2. THIS COURT ORDERS that the Receiver's Interim Statement of Receipts and Disbursements for the period from January 26, 2024 to May 15, 2024 be and is hereby approved.
- 3. THIS COURT ORDERS that the fees and disbursements of the Receiver and its legal counsel as described in the First Report, the fee affidavit of Bryan A. Tannenbaum, sworn May 22, 2024 and the fee affidavit of Beatrice Loschiavo, sworn May 22, 2024 are hereby approved.

C. Sealing Order

4. THIS COURT ORDERS that the Asset Purchase Agreement, dated April 28, 2024, being Confidential Appendix 1 to the First Report shall be treated as confidential, sealed and not form part of the public court record until all conditions to closing the asset purchase agreement between the Receiver and Toronto Capital (Stayner) Corp. in Trust, dated April 28, 2024, have been satisfied or waived by the Receiver and the Purchaser and the Transaction has been completed to the satisfaction of the Receiver.

D. General

5. THIS COURT ORDERS that the First Report and the conduct and activities of the Receiver set out therein be and are hereby approved.

- 6. THIS COURT ORDERS that only the Receiver, in its personal capacity and only with respect to its own personal liability, shall be entitled to rely upon or utilize in any way that approval of the First Report detailed in paragraph 5 above.
- 7. THIS COURT ORDERS that this Order and all of its provisions are effective as of 12:01 a.m. Toronto Time on the date of this Order and are enforceable without the need for entry and filing.
