Endorsement

The Receiver seeks a discharge order on this motion. The Applicant, The Toronto-Dominion Bank, has decided that it does not wish to further fund the receivership relating to the Respondent. The Receiver has had little success in locating the books and records and the assets for the debtor company. One of its shareholders, represented by Mr. Lachmansingh, agreed to be examined and has agreed that his examination transcript may be provided to the Applicant.

All parties have been served with the Motion Record. I have reviewed the Third Report of the Receiver (RSM Canada Limited), which is its final report. The report appears to be in order and the fees of the Receiver and its counsel appear to be reasonable.

The Discharge Order shall issue in the form of the draft attached hereto and signed by me. The Order is effective as of today's date and it is not required that it be entered.
