THIS Application by Firm Capital Mortgage Fund Inc., a creditor of Carrington Homes Ltd., for a bankruptcy order, was heard this day at Toronto, Ontario,

ON READING THE Affidavit of Verification and the Notice of Dispute, filed, and on hearing submissions of counsel for the Applicant and Carrington Homes Ltd., and the evidence of witnesses at the hearing, and it appearing to the Court that the following act of Bankruptcy has been committed:

Carrington Homes Ltd. has ceased to meet its liabilities generally as they become due.

1. THIS COURT HEREBY ORDERS that Carrington Homes Ltd., carrying on business in the Town of Richmond Hill, Province of Ontario, be adjudged bankrupt by virtue of a Bankruptcy Order hereby made on this date.
2. THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS that Collins Barrow Toronto Limited of the Province of Ontario, be appointed as Trustee of the Estate of the Bankrupt.

3. THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS that the Trustee give security in cash or by bond or suretyship, without delay, in accordance with subsection 16(1) of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act*.
4. THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS that the Costs of the Applicant creditor, fixed in the sum of ^{over 1,950}7362 be paid out of the Estate of the Bankrupt.
