ENDORSEMENT OF JUSTICE KIMMEL:

[1] On consent of the participating parties, the motion by the debtor, Mr. Suitor, regarding payment of his counsel's fees (the "Debtor Fees Approval Motion") that was returnable on

- June 16, 2025 is adjourned to a date to be set at a 30 minute case conference that has been scheduled on July 2, 2025 at 9:30 a.m. The June 16, 2025 hearing date has been vacated.
- [2] It is anticipated that the parties will have received, in advance of this case conference, the court's decision on a Sale Process Motion that is continuing on June 18, 2025, the outcome of which could impact whether the Debtor Fees Approval Motion needs to be heard. If the court's decision on the Sale Process Motion has not been rendered sufficiently in advance of the July 2, 2025 case conference to allow the parties time to work out a timetable for the pre-hearing steps for the Debtor Fee Approval Motion, they may jointly write to the court to request an adjournment of that case conference to another fixed date.
- [3] The parties may also timetable and address the re-scheduling of that portion of the Receiver's Sale Process Motion dealing with approval of the Receiver's fees and costs relating to the interim receivership motion, that was also adjourned to June 16, 2025. In the meantime, that aspect of the Receiver's motion is also adjourned to the July 2, 2025 case conference to be timetabled and scheduled, if it is proceeding.
